A very special group of women who support the Library through regular sponsorship. If you are interested in becoming a WoLF, please contact the Library during business hours for more details.

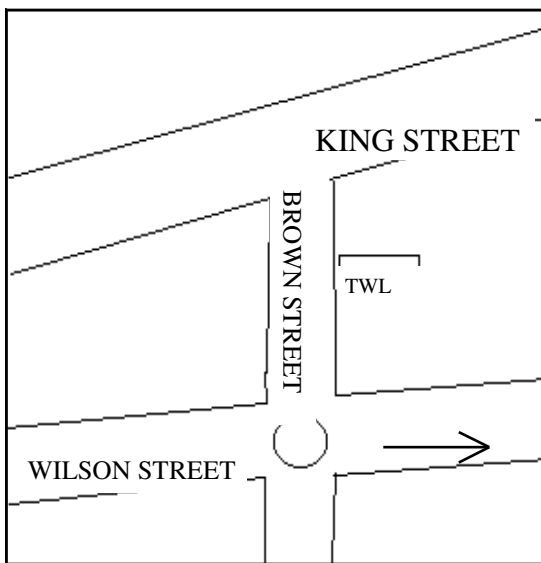
Donated Books

The Women's Library is a unique resource specialising in books by, for and about women. It provides a peaceful space for reading and thinking.

The Library, which is managed and run by volunteers, is always happy to welcome new members, volunteers and financial sponsors.

We welcome all devotees of reading, studying, socialising and relaxing. It's a great place and an unparalleled resource.

The library holds a wide variety of fiction genres from murder mysteries and historical novels to social satire, erotica and romance.

We also have a substantial non-fiction collection with topics ranging from Domestic Violence to Travel, Finance to Religion, Spirituality to Humor.

We have DVD's and videotapes you can borrow and a children's area, with books and toys. Members can borrow up to 6 books for a period of 2 weeks.

If you are unable to come into The Women's Library, or live outside the Sydney area, you can borrow up to 6 books for 4 weeks.

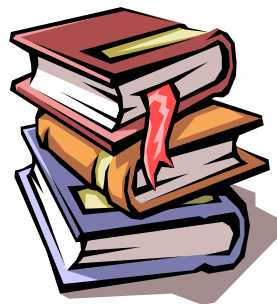
The Women's Library is physically accessible and there is an allocated accessible car park directly outside.

The Women's Library collection focuses on feminist and lesbian literature and journals.

Some of the books are self-published and/or from small women's presses and are not widely available.

Some members use the library's exhibition space to hang their artistic work which adds visual excitement to the walls—a viable alternative to commercial galleries.
